CLUB RULES

Membership Fees

Membership and Affiliation Fees Playing Member:

School Years 4 – 9 = £65

School Years 10 – 13 = £75

Over 18 = £95

In addition players shall pay a monthly subscription of £10.00 by standing order or £4.00 a week at outdoor training sessions.

This season there is an increased fee of an additional £5 per indoor training session. This fee needs to be paid on the night to cover the extra cost of indoor training.

There is also a £2.00 match fee for all league games and a match fee for tournaments which is advised separately.

Membership and Affiliation are non-refundable and are used to pay for the affiliation fees to AENA.

Certain kit items are also included in the membership fee, check each years pack to see what items you are entitled to.

Subscriptions are non-refundable but may be suspended in the event of injury or under other special circumstances at the discretion of the committee. It is the responsibility of each member to cancel their standing order in the event of long term illness/injury or upon leaving the Club.

Monthly standing order payments are to be done for a 12 month period at a time (July to June etc). Early cancellation and still remaining as a member of the club may result in being asked to pay the difference between weekly attendance and the standing order amounts received.

Any member who falls one month behind with their subs shall receive a letter/email as a reminder and will be asked to pay within 7 days of receipt of the letter. Failure to do so may result in the suspension of the netballing activities of that member until such time as their subs are paid up to date.

Team Selections

Selections will be made by the coaches based on Ability, Compatibility and Attendance at training. This will be done by the coaches at each training session & members will be informed then if they are required to play in the next match.

All members are to submit their availability online, through the website, by Tuesday 12:00pm the week before any matches, coaches will select the squad from the website information.

If a players attendance at training falls below 50% they will not be allowed to play in matches until it has gone above that mark.

Matches/Practices

Player Must:

Attend practices, apologies to be given via website or text/whatsapp in the event of illness/holiday.

Give a high level of commitment to their team-mates and to make themselves available for all matches in the season.

Give at least one weeks notice of unavailability for league matches except in the event of illness when every effort should be made to inform the team manager or coach before 10am to enable a replacement to be found.

Contact Team Managers to confirm any arrangements about matches.

Be of good conduct at all times and obey the rules of the game, accept as final any decision given by an official, no matter how unfair it may seem. When playing under the name and affiliation of Surrey Heath Netball Club, you are representing the club; inappropriate behavior on or off court is not acceptable and will be dealt with by the club.

Players Must Not:

Interfere with or undermine decisions taken by the Team Manager/coaches or umpires.

By any action on or off court bring the Club into disrepute.

Team Managers

Ensure that her team know dates and times of matches and are available to play.

Liaise with the Club Secretary in the event of a match date needing to be re-arranged.

At the end of all matches ensure that all details on the card are correct, especially the score and that both umpires have signed it and are happy with your teams conduct.

During the season the Team Manager will be responsible for keeping their team informed of any events that the club may be running.

The Team Manager will ensure that her team complies with the constitution and Rules of the Club. The Team Manager will report to the Chairman or secretary any problems that may arise within their team, including any incidents which may bring the club into disrepute.

Code of Conduct

All members and parents, associated to the club must sign the relevant code of conduct forms.

Club Forms.

The club may ask for up to date forms to be filled in and returned the next week, failure to respond to the deadline could result in missing matches.

Disciplinary

All players and club associated people must abide by the club rules and by breaking them will face disciplinary action.

1 st rule break	verbal warning
2 nd rule break	warning by either letter or email and suspension from 1 match.
3 rd rule break	if this is within 6 months of the first two then that person will be asked to leave the club.
